President's Message



Dear KOTAA members:

Happy New Year!

I hope that everything is going well for all KOTAA members. 2009 was a tough year due to global economic difficulties. I sincerely hope for improvements

in 2010. Looking back at the past 20 years, I believe that the KOTAA was remarkably successful thanks to the efforts of previous KOTAA leaders and members. I challenge our current members to strive for another leap of success, as we are responsible for the future of the KOTAA.

It has already been over 20 years since Korean professionals and students working in the transportation area first met during the TRB. The annual TRB meetings have provided us with valuable opportunities to meet many Koreans in the transportation field and have led us to form the KOTAA. Despite various challenges, the KOTAA has been extremely successful during the past 20 years. Now, the KOTAA plays a key role in connecting worldwide Korean transportation professionals. With financial stability, the KOTAA is also able to provide travel grants to students who present their work in the TRB.

Meanwhile, I would like to reassess the main purpose of the KOTAA and what we need to do next. The KOTAA bylaw states that the main purpose of KOTAA is to promote relationships and friendships among Korean Transportation Professionals in Korea and North America, to improve the development of members' consciousness, and to contribute to the expansion of transportation science and research, as well as industrial growth in Korea and North America. We have been successful in promoting relationships and friendships among us; however, our main activities remain limited within TRB.

I would like to propose two additional efforts for the future of KOTAA. First, I strongly believe that another meeting should be scheduled (in addition to the annual meeting during TRB) to strengthen the professional affiliations among our members. As most KOTAA members may know, the Korean American Scientists and Engineers Association (KSEA) hosts a US-Korea conference (UKC) every summer. This is a great opportunity for KOTAA members to meet and collaborate in a more relaxed setting. We can share our own research activities and discuss ways to contribute to the expansion of transportation science and research in Korea and the U.S. This year, UKC will be held in August in Seattle, Washington. I would like to have a summer KOTAA meeting during the UKC. I strongly encourage all KOTAA members to attend the summer meeting.

Secondly, I would like to start developing local branches of the KOTAA. The number of KOTAA members continues to increase every year; on the other hand, we are losing opportunities to build close relationships with others. Our superficial relationships ultimately act counterproductively, detracting from our main goals. The summer KOTAA meeting provides an opportunity to build better and closer relations among members. In addition, activities within a local area will give us a chance to fortify our current relationships. Forming local branches will also stimulate communication among local members, and act as a means to collect and share news and information. This year, I would like to ask KOTAA travel grant recipients to start gathering member information in their area.

I hope that all KOTAA members can help each other for our future, and that everyone is successful in his or her ambitions in the career of transportation.
